Permission for my child to walk to and from school without adult supervision

- I understand that children will be expected to follow the **Playground Use Agreement for Before and After School** (see reverse).
- I have gone through this with my child and I verify that s/he is clear about what s/he can and can't do.
- I understand that failure to abide by the terms of the agreement may result in my child losing this privilege.
- I also understand that in allowing my child to come to school without supervision, I am entrusting them to take responsibility for their own safety and the safety of others and that the school and its staff are not responsible for supervision until 8.55am.
- **Children who are going home without an adult should do so at 3.30pm.**

Playground Use Agreement for Before and After School

- Parents should be responsible for their child until the bell rings at 8.55am and from when they collect their child from the class teacher at 3.30pm
- The Junior trim trail (top playground/blue surface) should be used by children from Year 3 to Year 6.
- The Infant trim trail should only be used by children up to and including Year 2.
- The Infant trim trail may be used by younger children (siblings etc.) but parents and carers should take responsibility for their safety.
- We do not wish to prevent children from using the trails, but the school cannot take responsibility for children's safety before 8.55am or after 3.30pm. The supervision of the child is the responsibility of the parent or carer during this time.
- The trails are not to be used in wet or icy conditions.
- Children should dismount from bikes and scooters before entering the school gates and walk their bike or scooter to the parking rack.
- The school trikes and scooters are not for use before or after school.
- Playground equipment (skipping ropes, hoops, balls etc.) should not be used before and after school, except for balls in the football cage. All balls should be put back into the blue cage when the bell goes or before leaving.

This user agreement will only be effective with your support and we encourage you to reinforce this agreement with your child(ren) or the child(ren) in your care.
